Light gold. Gentle on the nose suggestive of herbal tea, wild plants and peaches. Exquisite palate, elegantly revealing an extremely complex aromatic spectrum. Persistent freshness. Clear potential.

The Ventoux appellation wine Hautes Pierres blanc 2013, 56% Grenache / 44% Roussane, vinified and aged in oak barrels for 12 months reveals delicate aromas of almonds and limeblossom. Sophisticated and vivacious on the palate with a lovely finish.

Half Grenache blanc, half Clairette, an exquisite, floral, ample, subtle, round wine, well balanced by a delicate mineral structure.

Hautes Pierres Rouge 2012

Guide Gilbert et Gaillard 2016: [Gold medal](#) **88/100**

Deep garnet. Expressive nose of red and black fruits with mild spices and roasted coffee notes. Straight attack leading into a very concentrated, full palate with upfront tannins. Intense, cocoa-driven finish. Powerful, well balanced and seductive.

The Hautes Pierres rouge 2012, a blend of Syrah (80 %) with 20% Red Grenache aged 12 months in French oak barrels, is a rich, full bodied and concentrated wine with hints of prunes and brambles and slightly peppered in the finish. Excellent ageing.

Guide Hachette 2016 **1 star ***

The deep garnet color is a signature of the main blend of Syrah (80% with a complement of Grenache). On the nose, hints of leather, pepper, violets and red fruits, typical of Syrah. Built on soft tannins, the ample and powerful palate with scents of cocoa and roasted coffee, signature of the oak barrel ageing finishes with a lingering fruity touch.

Deep cherry-red with youthful highlights. Delightful nose combining red and black fruits with a floral touch. Fruit-driven attack leading into a supple, fairly concentrated palate with full-on fruit expression. Spicy at the finish.

The Terre d'Ocres rouge 2014, 50% Grenache et 50% Carignan, softly tannic, with pleasant scents of blackberries, spices on the palate giving roundness and structure.

Half Grenache, half Carignan, this rosé wine suggests white fruits and fennel bouquet on the nose. A delightful balance between deepness and acidity and a fine lingering.
